NDFD 2026 Fireworks Restrictions & Safety Recommendations

Legal consumer fireworks may only be discharged in designated areas on the following dates and times. For questions, call North Davis Fire District at 801-525-2850. For emergencies, call 911.

- July 2, 2026: between 11:00 am and 11:00 pm
- July 3, 2026: between 11:00 am and 11:00 pm
- July 4, 2026: between 11:00 am and 12:00 am (*hours extended*)
- July 5, 2026: between 11:00 am and 11:00 pm

- July 22, 2026: between 11:00 am and 11:00 pm
- July 23, 2026: between 11:00 am and 11:00 pm
- July 24, 2026: between 11:00 am and 12:00 am (*hours extended*)
- July 25, 2026: between 11:00 am and 11:00 pm

Firework Discharge Safety Recommendations:

- Only discharge fireworks in the designated areas.
- Only discharge legal consumer fireworks.
- Always have adult supervision. Only responsible adults should light fireworks.
- Always have water available.
- Keep fireworks away from children and pets.
- Beware of your surroundings.
- Before lighting fireworks ensure that the area near the ignition site is free from people and animals.
- Only ignite one firework at a time and move a safe distance away after lighting the firework.
- Never attempt to relight a firework that does not ignite.
- Wait a minimum of 15 minutes before approaching a “dud” firework.

Firework Cleanup & Disposal

- Fully submerge ALL used and “dud” fireworks in a metal bucket of water overnight before disposing of them. Failure could result in “hot spots” that could reignite and cause a fire in or around the disposal area.
- Double wrap the water-soaked fireworks in plastic wrap or a plastic bag so that they do not dry out, then place in your regular trash can.
